King Slide Group announces DO NOT use conflict minerals Statement

Conflict Minerals refers tin (Sn), tantalum (Ta), tungsten (W), gold (Au) from the mine in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or neighboring countries conflict area. As the conflict in the region are controlled by non-governmental armed groups, illegal mining and the cause of human rights violations.

United States has announced the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Law Section of the financial reform bill in section 1502 that is used to regulate the origin source of conflict minerals used in products.

King Slide Group declares that all metal used in our products DOES NOT come from the Democratic Republic of the Congo Congolese and any its neighboring countries, nor any neighboring countries in conflict area where the conflict in the region are controlled by non-governmental armed groups, illegal mining and the cause of human rights violations.

Conflict-Free Sourcing Initiative (CFSI) procurement plan of Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT) are both implemented for investigation. In between suppliers are also required to comply investigate reasonably to be responsible ensuring materials supply to King Slide does not have conflict mineral in order to comply all customer and law requirement.
